Contracting Covid-19 infection	Contracting Covid-19 from surfaces duiring use of changing rooms and toilets	Showers remain closed until further easing of restrictions and/or additional control measures available
		Sanitize Gents changing room, Gents toilets (Clubhouse), Ladies toilets/changing
		rooms using disinfectant spray when opened up and when closed up. Provide hand sanitizer outside doors of Gents changing room, Gents toilets (Clubhouse), Ladies toilets/changing rooms to be used on entering and leaving the area.
		Wedge open doors to Gents toilets (Clubhouse), Ladies toilets/changing rooms. This provides line of sight into the changing rooms so that before entering the area a check can be made that the toilet unoccupied. Also, provides good air flow and circulation. A rope across door system introduced to ensure toilet is unoccupied brfore entering.
		Disconnect manually oprated warm air hand dryer and provide paper towels.
		Provide spray disinfectant in toilets and changing areas to be used on touched surfaces e.g. toilet flush handle, toilet seat, cubicle door, taps.
		Once changed, members to remove all possessions from changing areas and store in car or other suitable area.
		Restrict use of Gents changing room, Gents toilets (Clubhouse), Ladies toilets/changing rooms. Availbiliy only when opened and closed up by a committee member and the above measures are put in place.
		Face coverings to be worn if more than one member in Gents Changing room
Maintaining Social Distancing	Contracting Covid-19 directly from another person	Limit number of people allowed in Gents Changing room to 4 people and in Gents toilets (Clubhouse) and Ladies toilets/changing to 1 person.
		Wedge open doors to Gents toilets (Clubhouse), Ladies toilets/changing room doors allowing a vocal check to be made that area is unoccupied before entering.
Personnel not following procedures	Compromising control measures to minimise risk of contracting Covid-19	Provide signage at sanitizing station outside Gents Changing Rooms, Gents toilets (Clubhouse) and Ladies toilets/changing room and inside these areas to advise on safety procedures.

Summary of Essential Controls and Actions

Provide santising stations outside Gents toilets (Clubhouse) and Ladies toilets/changing room (Barry Knights/David Islin)

Provide disinfectant sprays inside Gents toilets (Clubhouse) and Ladies toilets/changing room (Barry Knights/David Islin)

Provide signage indicating safety procedures for using Club changing areas and toilets (Tony Everitt).

Rearrange Gents Changing room to provide changing facilities for maximum of 4 people (Barry Knights/David Islin)
